Blank is an artist run, not-for-profit organisation comprising 12 studios, 25 artists and a gallery. We work in a wide range of disciplines: photography, sound, installation, puppetry, ceramics, performance, jewellery, theatre, video, model making, movement and sculpture. Other skills include art therapy, creative counselling and workshop facilitation.

Blank Days is an immersive day of creative work in our dedicated space, with a choice of participatory workshops in a well-supported professional environment alongside exhibiting artists and experienced creative practitioners.

What happens in a BLANK DAY?

A Blank Day offers a flexible format for between 4 and 20 people to attend a series of workshops selected in advance from a menu.

A typical format is a list of 4 workshops with each person choosing one morning and one afternoon session. There is ample time for feedback, further talk with the artists and idea sharing over a delicious buffet lunch.

The emphasis is on creativity and enjoyment, team-building and skill-sharing. The workshops are all participatory so that each person will have made, painted or created something by the end of the day. There is a great deal of flexibility in the way days are set up to include group work sessions or focus days that fit with existing schemes of work.

We can respond to specific requirements, can offer consultation sessions and will discuss and plan in advance to ensure all participants get the best from the day.
